Planned engineering work and other timetable alterations

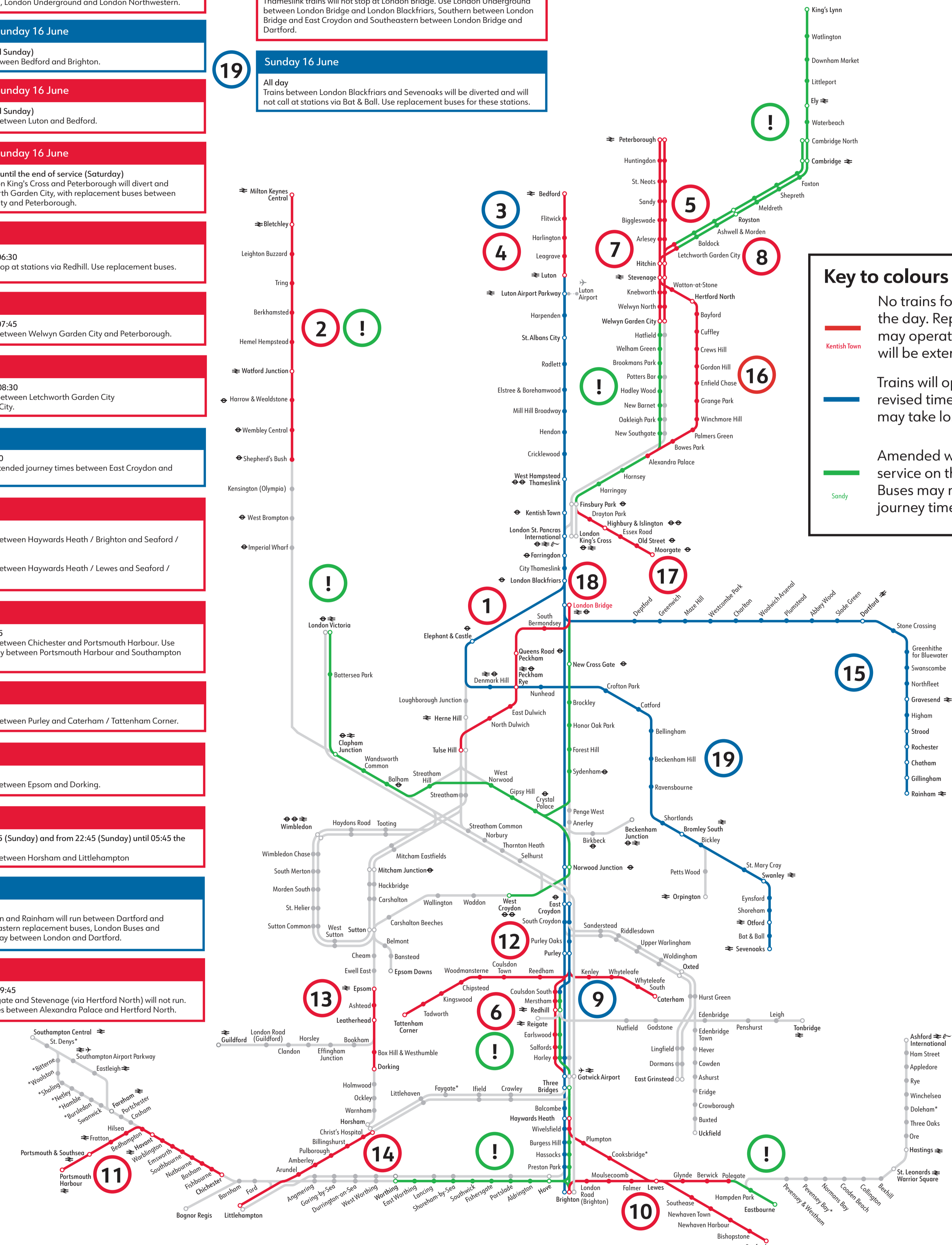
- 1** Saturday 15 to Sunday 16 June
All day (Saturday and Sunday)
Buses replace trains between London Bridge and Tulse Hill.
- 2** Saturday 15 to Sunday 16 June
From 18:30 (Saturday) until 12:15 (Sunday)
No trains between Shepherds Bush and Watford Junction / Milton Keynes Central. Use Southern, London Underground and London Northwestern.
- 3** Saturday 15 to Sunday 16 June
All day (Saturday and Sunday)
Revised timetable between Bedford and Brighton.
- 4** Saturday 15 to Sunday 16 June
All day (Saturday and Sunday)
Buses replace trains between Luton and Bedford.
- 5** Saturday 15 to Sunday 16 June
From 00:40 (Sunday) until the end of service (Saturday)
Trains between London King's Cross and Peterborough will divert and terminate at Letchworth Garden City, with replacement buses between Letchworth Garden City and Peterborough.
- 6** Sunday 16 June
Start of service until 06:30
Some trains will not stop at stations via Redhill. Use replacement buses.
- 7** Sunday 16 June
Start of service until 07:45
Buses replace trains between Welwyn Garden City and Peterborough.
- 8** Sunday 16 June
Start of service until 08:30
Buses replace trains between Letchworth Garden City and Welwyn Garden City.
- 9** Sunday 16 June
From 00:45 until 06:30
Services subject to extended journey times between East Croydon and Coulsdon South.
- 10** Sunday 16 June
Until 10:00
Buses replace trains between Haywards Heath / Brighton and Seaford / Polegate.
After 10:00
Buses replace trains between Haywards Heath / Lewes and Seaford / Polegate.
- 11** Sunday 16 June
From 00:30 until 12:45
Buses replace trains between Chichester and Portsmouth Harbour. Use South Western Railway between Portsmouth Harbour and Southampton Central.
- 12** Sunday 16 June
All day
Buses replace trains between Purley and Caterham / Tattenham Corner.
- 13** Sunday 16 June
All day
Buses replace trains between Epsom and Dorking.
- 14** Sunday 16 June
From 00:15 until 08:15 (Sunday) and from 22:45 (Sunday) until 05:45 the following morning
Buses replace trains between Horsham and Littlehampton
- 15** Sunday 16 June
All day
Trains between London and Rainham will run between Dartford and Rainham. Use Southeastern replacement buses, London Buses and Docklands Light Railway between London and Dartford.
- 16** Sunday 16 June
Start of service until 09:45
Trains between Moorgate and Stevenage (via Hertford North) will not run. Use replacement buses between Alexandra Palace and Hertford North.

- 17** Sunday 16 June
From 09:15 until the end of service
Trains to / from Moorgate will be diverted to London King's Cross. Use London Underground / Buses between Finsbury Park and Moorgate.
- 18** Sunday 16 June
All day
Thameslink trains will not stop at London Bridge. Use London Underground between London Bridge and London Blackfriars, Southern between London Bridge and East Croydon and Southeastern between London Bridge and Dartford.
- 19** Sunday 16 June
All day
Trains between London Blackfriars and Sevenoaks will be diverted and will not call at stations via Bot & Ball. Use replacement buses for these stations.

Late night and early morning alterations
Late night and early morning services may also be altered for planned engineering work.
Plan ahead at nationalrail.co.uk if you are planning to travel after 21:00 or before 06:00 as train times may be revised and buses may replace trains.

Key to colours

- No trains for all or part of the day. Replacement buses may operate. Journey times will be extended.
- Trains will operate to a revised timetable - journeys may take longer.
- Amended weekday overnight service on this line. Buses may replace trains and journey times extended.
